HAND SPUN YARN

One entry - per Class - per spinner. Contestant should spin skein of yarn after April 2008. Each skein should be 100% plant fiber or 100% animal fiber - 2oz. weight.

Judging guidelines:

1. Purpose of your knitting: weaving (weft or warp), etc. Be specific.
2. Preparation of fiber: cleanliness and even color distribution.
3. Consistency of twist: size and strength
4. Hand and Finish: correct skeining and feel of yarn
5. Important ~ not all yarns to spun smooth and even.
