AWARDS: *The Youth and School Art Exhibit is a non juried show.*

1. Participant ribbons for each student exhibitor
2. First place thru fifth place will receive ribbons.
3. Honorable mentions will receive ribbons.
4. Best of Class: each grade level
5. Judges Choice: criteria: number and quality of entries - presentation and attitude of entries:
 - Art Teacher
 - Elementary School Teacher
 - High School Teacher

EXHIBITORS PLEASE NOTE:

1. Group or class projects accepted: participants residing in Maricopa County and enrolled in pre-school thru high school - **use form G** (list as many students as possible - forms can be duplicated). Include: school name - student name - division and class number for *each* entry. Teachers are responsible for placing entry tags on art work. Tags will be provided at receiving.
2. Student entering without a school affiliation use **form M**

3. A parent may enter their child's exhibit - *family members cannot share an entry form*
4. Up to 4 items/entries - per exhibitor - per class.
- 4A. It is the teacher's responsibility to place entry tag(s) on the work. Entry tags will be provided by the fair.
5. Entries created by exhibitor and created *after* the 2009 Fair.
6. Models and/or kits not accepted. (a parent signature must be included indicating verification)
7. Display guidelines:
 - Matt or frame entries. **To display exhibits it is necessary to staple into matting. Quality of matting has no bearing on judging - inexpensive matting ok!*
 - Protect entries with plastic / plastic wrap - *No glass*
 - Pastels, charcoal, oil pastels, watercolor and ink can be sprayed with plastic coating or hair spray or protected as indicated above.
 - Art work on wood or on stretch bars - *securely* attach wire for hanging. Exhibits, without properly attached wiring, will *not* be accepted. *Do not use string or tape.*

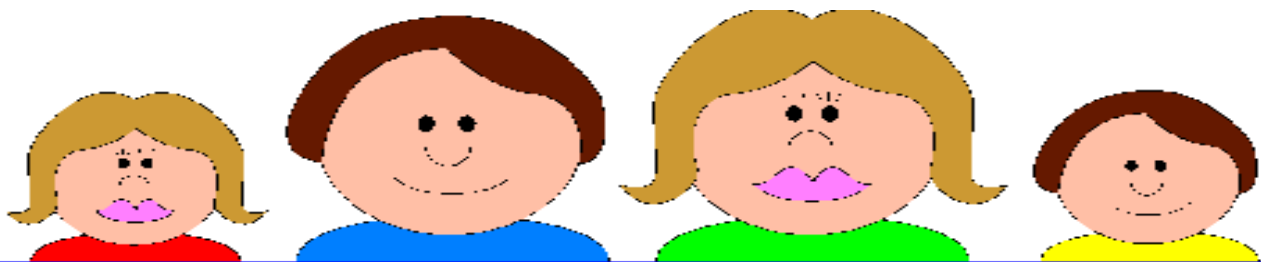
