### HOME ARTS- Sewing and Fiber Arts EXHIBITORS PLEASE NOTE:

In this department we have Youth: age 5 – 12, Teen: age 13 – 18, Adult: age 19 + and Person(s) with Disabilities. **Be sure to indicate the correct age group on the entry form.** If exhibitor is less than 18 years of age, include your age and your parent signature where indicated. Failure to comply with these rules may result in entry disqualification of the entry.

### Read instructions carefully:

1. Entry must be listed in the Exhibitor Handbook.
2. Entry created by exhibitor.
3. Pin name on paper inside garment.
4. Judges will turn garments inside out to check seams and for loose threads. **Please iron garment.**
5. Entries should be created after 2016 Fair.
6. Entries stained or unsanitary will not be accepted.
7. Exhibits consisting of one or more pieces must be mounted or securely fastened together. Failure to comply may result in disqualification.
8. The Maricopa County Fair is not responsible for loss or damage to any exhibit.
9. The Maricopa County Fair and/or the Home Arts- Sewing and Fiber Arts Department are not responsible for items left after release date.
10. Premiums will be mailed, to the address on the entry form, after the Fair.
11. Exhibitors are allowed to enter unlimited number of entries per class as long as each is paid with a \$1 entry fee prior to deadline day and \$2 entry fee after deadline.

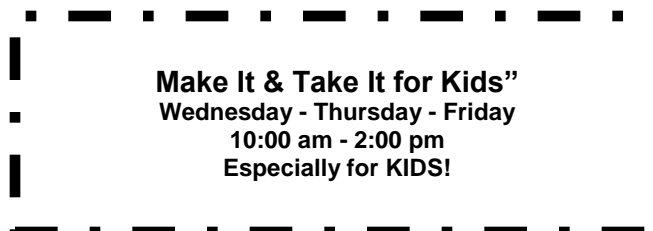

**HAND SPUN YARN**

One entry - per Class - per spinner. Contestant should spin skein of yarn after April 2016. Each skein should be 100% plant fiber or 100% animal fiber - 2oz. weight.

**Judging guidelines:**

1. Purpose of your knitting: weaving (weft or warp), etc. Be specific.
2. Preparation of fiber: cleanliness and even color distribution.
3. Consistency of twist: size and strength
4. Hand and Finish: correct skeining and feel of yarn
5. Important ~ not all yarns to spun smooth and even.
