Complete entries include online entry plus Exhibitor Signature form with all signatures and entry fees. **Entries MUST be entered online and supporting documents must be delivered to the office at the address listed below. SHOWMANSHIP: Wednesday, April 8, starting at 9 am

JUDGING: Breed Divisions - 15 minutes after Dairy Goat Showmanship, going in numerical order.

HERDSMANSHIP: Awards will be presented to participating Dairy Clubs/Pygmy Goat Clubs:

Areas will be checked twice daily. The top three 4-H/FFA/Open Youth Clubs will be given the following awards:

First-\$50 Second-\$25 Third-\$15

DAIRY GOAT EXHIBITORS PLEASE NOTE:

1. This show is not an ADGA sanctioned show, however, ADGA rules shall govern. All does must be registered in the youth exhibitor's name with either ADGA, AGS, or CGS. Animals not meeting this criteria WILL NOT be allowed to show. Does under six months of age can be shown with an official stamped duplicate registration.
2. All animals must be kept in livestock area. Any exhibitor found with their animal outside livestock area will not be allowed to participate in the auction.
3. Age base is April 12, 2017. Use the base date to establish the age of the animal for proper class placement for the show.
4. All dairy goats will be mouthed for age at check in.
5. Any doe over 24 months of age, never freshened, cannot be shown in breed classes, but may be shown in showmanship.
6. Scurs, over 2" on does, not accepted.
7. Bucks over 4 months of age and horned animals are not eligible.
8. Animals are to come clipped/trimmed - show ready at check-in.
9. Exhibitors are responsible for tattoos on animals entering the show ring.
10. Pens will be assigned by the Superintendent based on the number of animals entered. No pen switching will be allowed. Tack pens will be assigned only if space is available. No pen consideration will be made for animals not entered in the show.
11. Maricopa County Fair Dress Code required. *Refer to Livestock Rules - #25*

12. **Any exhibitor that is already entered into the YDG department will be able to enter kids born after the entry deadline, at receiving.**
13. Dairy goats will be selling in the large livestock auction and not the small stock auction. There will be a total of 5 spots available for dairy goats to sell in the largestock auction. Eligible animals for the sale will be determined by placing and if you wish to sell. Animals must be entered and judged in Division 3208: Dairy goats for Auction, to be eligible to sell.

DIVISION 3208: Dairy Goats for Auction

Animals must be entered in this division if they wish to participate in the Livestock Auction.

1. Exhibitors *MUST* inform the superintendent immediately following show, their choice to sell or not to sell.
2. Exhibitors can enter 2 but are limited to sell a total of one Dairy Goat in the Auction.
3. This class will use the Danish Judging System.

Class Description

114	Wether or Buck: any breed or mix - January 1, 2017, or after
115	Doe: any age

DIVISION 3215: Showmanship - \$2 Entry Fee

Animals must be entered as a breed animal to be participate in showmanship. Only Dairy Goats in Class 100, 101, 102, 103, 104 and 105 are eligible. Must be entered at time of Entry or there will be an Onsite Entry fee of Double the entry fee after the deadline.

Class Description

100	Junior Novice: Junior member - first year project
101	Junior: 9yrs -12yrs prior to Jan. 1, 2017
102	Intermediate Novice: Intermediate member - first year project
103	Intermediate: 13yrs -15yrs prior to Jan. 1, 2017
104	Senior Novice: Senior member - first year project
105	Senior: 16yrs -18yrs prior to Jan. 1, 2017
