CAVY EXHIBITORS PLEASE NOTE:

1. Exhibitor must indicate if they wish to sell a qualifying animal by placing a “Y” or “N” in the sell column online at time of entry. Once you have made this declaration, you will not be allowed to change this declaration. If more than 1 are eligible for the sale that were marked “Y”, auction committee and auction clerk will make the final decision as to which one will sell.
1. 4-H, FFA and Open Youth eligible to enter.
2. Diseased or unsightly cavies will not be admitted and must be removed from the fairgrounds.
3. All animals must be ear tagged prior to arrival on receiving day.
4. No breeding of animals will be allowed on the fairgrounds at any time.
5. **Waterers & feeders must be furnished by the exhibitor. Exhibitors are responsible for feeding their animals throughout the fair. Morning feedings must be done by 10 am and evening feedings must be done by 8:30 pm.**
6. Maricopa County Dress Code required.
7. Removal of show animals, prior to the end of fair is prohibited. **NO EXCEPTIONS.**

**The Division, Class and sub class for each animal must be on the entry form.
 Ex: Abyssinian Brindle Senior boar would be Division 3800 Class 101 Subclass C**
